NPA Midwest Roles and Responsibilities for the Board of Directors

The Board of Directors is responsible for directing the affairs of the Association and is legally responsible for its actions.

Attendance: Directors must attend a monthly telephone or electronic conference call, and may be excused with notice from no more than two such calls per year. Directors must attend all in-person meetings including Natural Foods Day in Washington, D.C. (usually held in the springtime) and the annual meeting at NPA Midwest Trade Show (currently held in the summer).

Confidentiality: All matters that come before the Board are confidential. All Directors are required to maintain confidentiality in all Board matters, and are required to execute a Confidentiality Agreement.

Duties: Directors are expected to commit additional time over and above attendance at regularly scheduled meetings. Under normal circumstances, Directors should be prepared to spend an average of four hours per month on Association work as may be assigned by the President. In addition, from time to time, Directors may be asked by the President to serve on committees and to perform other such work as may be required by the Association.

Speaking with One Voice: Directors are expected to participate in discussions and debate of all motions before the Board. Once those motions are adopted, Directors are expected to embrace the spirit of the motion regardless of how he or she may have voted, in order to represent the Association in a unified manner, speaking with one voice.

Board Continuation: In order to perpetuate the Board, Directors are expected to recruit candidates for Board service as vacancies may arise from time to time.

Association Continuation: In order to perpetuate the Association, Directors are expected to promulgate the mission of the Association, and to promote membership.
